- Competition is open to violin, viola, cello and bass students going into grades 9-12.
- Winners receive:
 - Special placement in an advanced string ensemble.
 - Two daily intensive string ensemble rehearsals and coaching by two faculty members.
 - Performance with faculty on Saturday's faculty recital, as well as a student-only performance on Friday's student recital.
 - Extra rehearsal time with faculty members.
 - A private lesson with a faculty member during camp.
- Winners will be chosen by performers/teachers not directly involved with the festival.
- Literature will be selected by faculty after auditions are complete and sent to winners for advance study.
- Audition submission must be postmarked by **February 15th, 2012**.

 - Résumé
 - Complete registration at <http://www.rlmf.org> or by mail using form from brochure.
 - \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee. Fee will be applied toward festival tuition, and may be paid online or by mail.
 - Audition DVD: Prepare two contrasting pieces that best represent your technical and musical ability, 10 minutes maximum.
 - Letter from teacher confirming student's readiness for this experience.
