

## **RLMF COVID – 19 Guidelines**

1. The Red Lodge Music Festival strongly encourages campers of all ages to complete their full COVID-19 vaccination course (including all eligible/applicable boosters) to help contribute to the safety of themselves and the campers, faculty, and staff that make up the RLMF community. In compliance with Montana State Law, the Red Lodge Music Festival cannot collect or require the submission of COVID-19 vaccination information for participants and/or staff.

2. All campers, faculty, staff, and volunteers are subject to surveillance testing throughout the week. Anyone **testing positive for COVID-19** will be sent home immediately. **Refunds will not be given for campers who leave mid-session.** All campers, faculty, staff, and volunteers will also be tested if they are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 at any point throughout the week. All camp participants should notify the Camp Director or Assistant Camp Director immediately if they are exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms. The Red Lodge Music Festival will comply with COVID-19 guidelines from the Montana Department of Health and the CDC that are current and in place at the time camp is in session in making camp removal determinations.

### **3. Masks and Bell Covers**

Masks and bell covers will not be required or provided. Students and staff are welcome to use them.

### **4. Positive Covid cases**

Should a camper or staff member test positive for Covid either during or immediately following camp, RLMF will work with the Local Health Department and follow their recommendations regarding contact tracing and camper notification. It is our intent to follow health department guidelines.
